Pest Control Services Information



Sand Mountain Pest Management, LLC has been awarded the pest control services bid. They do not use paper service logs. They have handheld devices which will be used in lieu of the paper service logs. We appreciate your help in having a representative of each building sign the hand held device of the Sand Mountain Pest technician after services have been rendered.

The schedule of services for our cafeteria on the Wallace Drive Campus as of now are to be rendered on the date as listed below and to be completed between 2 p.m. and 2:30 p.m. on said date. Please make sure there will be someone available in your area to sign for these services.

Wallace Drive Campus – Cafeteria – 2nd Tuesday & Wednesday of each month

The below services are covered in **Food Service Areas**:

- Interior Treatments – Bait, Traps, and Crevice Spraying
- Bait gels for cockroach control shall be used. When applied, baits shall be rotated to limit resistance.
- Boric acid shall be used in voids at least every 6 months.
- A growth regulator shall be applied at least quarterly.
- A sanitation report shall be completed monthly detailing the conditions found in the food service areas.
- Basic insect exclusion and habitat reduction shall be part of the IPM.
- Rodent control shall be done as needed with traps, baits, or minor exclusion. A tamper-resistant rodent station shall be maintained and serviced monthly in dumpster area of food service areas.
- Pest control service shall be performed after closing or before opening times for food service areas.
- All exposed metal (inside and outside) of dumpsters and grease barrels shall be treated for fly control.
- Grease stained areas of concrete pads shall be treated for fly control.
- “Attract and kill” zones shall be created each month for fly control:
 - ✓ On perimeter of building in non-public areas.
 - ✓ Near non-public areas.
- Glue boards shall be changed in light traps as needed.
- Bulbs shall be replaced once per year (peak season between March and May).
- Drains shall be cleaned with Vector Bio-5 (4 ounces per drain).

If the above services are not being rendered or if there is a pest control issue that needs addressed, please enter a work order on the Fixit Request Portal.

Sand Mountain Pest’s response time for emergency services should be within five (5) hours.
